1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Poisons Amendment Regulations 2019*.

2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on the day on which their making is notified in the *Gazette*.

3. Principal Regulations

In these regulations, the *Poisons Regulations 2018** are referred to as the Principal Regulations.

4. Regulation 58 amended (Supply of potent substances by pharmaceutical chemists)

Regulation 58 of the Principal Regulations is amended as follows:

- (a) by omitting from subregulation (3) “Schedule 2 substance” and substituting “substance listed in Schedule 3 to the Poisons List”;
- (b) by omitting from subregulation (5) “Schedule 2 substance” and substituting “substance listed in Schedule 3 to the Poisons List”.
