These regulations may be cited as the *Poisons Amendment Regulations* (No. 2) 2021.

2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on 1 July 2021.

3. Principal Regulations

In these regulations, the *Poisons Regulations* 2018* are referred to as the Principal Regulations.

4. Regulation 87 amended (Prescription, &c., of certain substances prohibited, unless authorised by Secretary)

Regulation 87(1) of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting paragraph (f).
